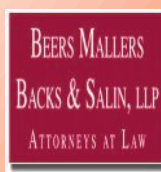

LIBRARY PARKING LOTS

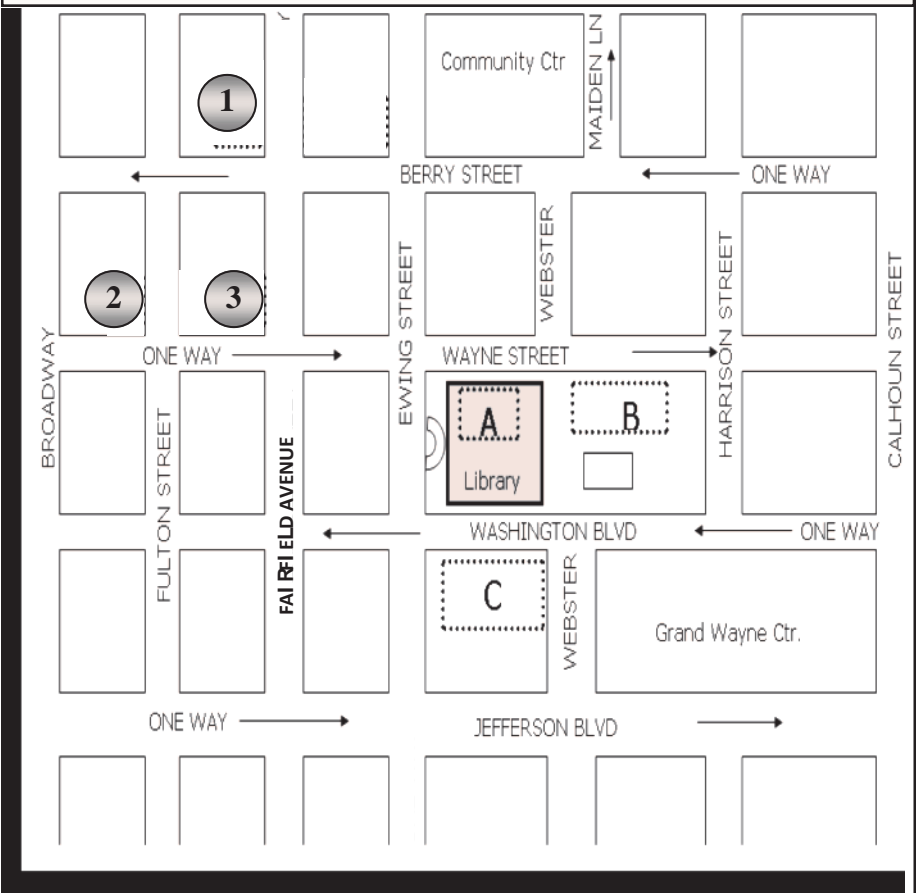
Free if you use your library card to validate your parking ticket in the Library. Lots open at 8:45 a.m.

- A. Underground Parking (128 spaces)**
Enter the building from Wayne Street.
- B. Wayne Street Lot East of Library (Please do not move cones)**
Enter from Wayne Street just East of the building.
- C. Washington Blvd. Lot across from Library Building (106 spaces)**
Enter from Webster Street which is accessible from either Washington Blvd. or Jefferson Blvd.

OTHER FREE PARKING AREAS

(limited space available)

Free shuttle service to the Library from lots 1, 2 and 3 every 15 minutes on a CTN 12 passenger van with wheelchair accessibility.

Plymouth Congregational Church (Lot on Berry Street)

Enter from Berry Street and park on the East side of the lot (closest to Fairfield).

Trinity Episcopal Church (Lot on West Wayne Street)

Enter from Wayne Street only.
(Please **DO NOT** park in Reserved Spaces.)

Trinity English Lutheran Church (Lot on West Wayne Street)

Access lot for SIF parking from West Wayne Street.
